Una, a 10 month old guide puppy who will soon be attending puppy school to learn how to be a guide dog and Millie, a retired a guide dog.

We discussed any fundraising ideas that the classes had thought of:

Caitlyn's class (Y6JJ) had suggested nail painting, face painting, a tombola and baking cakes to sell. While Parshvr (Y2B) suggested a lucky dip, Daniel (Y6MJ) a fun & games day, Priya (Y4P) a dress up day and Carmen (Y5CM) a book sale or book swap. Miss Whiteley also shared some possible fundraising ideas from Isobel, Phillippa, Kaela and Abigail in Year 4 which were a jumble sale, sell cakes, organise a winter disco, a football match and hold a movie night.

Miss Nicholson suggested that we organise an obstacle course that children complete blind folded with a person guiding them with children taking part paying £1 each.
