1. Welcome

Miss Nicholson and Miss Whiteley welcomed the school council representatives to the meeting.

2. Sport in School

The School Council talked about PE lessons and what is covered and what they would like to do during PE.

The Class Representatives overall liked their PE sessions and felt they were varied, however, Charlie and Scarlett stated that they did not enjoy doing Dance instead they would prefer tennis or rounders.

It was suggested by a number of councillors that they would like dodgeball, gymnastics, cheerleading, keep fit exercises and improving their throwing and catching skills included in their PE lessons.

The council then discussed the sports that have been offered for after school clubs over this year and asked if they would they like any of these sports repeated next year or any different ones?

Was there enough for girls, boys and different year groups to choose from?

The majority of council representatives have attended at least one sports based after school club. They stated that they have thoroughly enjoyed them. The few representatives that have not taken part said that they did not enjoy sports, and one wanted to do cricket (which is currently offered).

The sports that they would like considered for next year are:

Dodgeball, Benchball, Rounders, Basketball, Cricket, Hockey, Netball, Cheerleading, Table Tennis, Tag Rugby, Rugby, Football (boys, mixed and girls only), running/cross country running, athletics, trampolining, scooters, bikes (bikeability), golf and gymnastics.

All the Class representatives felt that there was currently enough to choose from for both girls and boys and liked that for some clubs that only certain aged children could participate.
