

# School Council Minutes Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2016

### 1. Welcome

Miss Whiteley welcomed school council to the meeting and then handed over to the chair (Saffron) who read through the agenda and welcomed Mrs Taylor to the meeting.

#### 2. <u>Safeguarding Poster</u>

Mrs Taylor talked to the school council about safeguarding, asking if they knew what the safeguarding meant and if they had a problem who they could go and speak to about it. Mrs Taylor talked about the members of the Safeguarding Team but also reinforcing that a child could speak to any member of staff.

## 4. <u>AOB</u>

Miss Whiteley asked if there was anything that pupils had raised for discussion.

Saffron spoke on behalf of Year 6 who would like more sports equipment for lunchtime play including a trampoline.

Year 5 would like another Allerton's Got Talent Competition. Zedekiah and Jaivon suggested that it could be used as a fundraiser, charge for tickets or to enter and then the money could be divided between the charities that the four houses are supporting.

Brikena spoke on behalf of Nursery who would like smaller tables to use while eating their lunches. The current tables have too big a gap between the seat and the table so they cannot reach properly.

Action: School council to discuss further at next meeting deciding for each request whether it should be taken further.
