#### **1. Welcome**

Miss Whiteley welcomed school council to the meeting.

#### **2. Feedback from the previous Meeting**

##### **Trim Trail and Playground Improvements**

Miss Whiteley asked the School Council Representatives for any feedback regarding ideas to improve the playground and existing Trim Trail.

Lana, Mya and Zain spoke on behalf of Year 1. They would like a climbing wall, a climbing frame, some ropes, jumping blocks, a wobbly bridge, a water play area, a slide, see-saw, monkey bars and swings with soft ground underneath the play equipment as well as a beach.

While Year 3 would like a look out and a sand pit and additions made to the trim trail and Year 4 would like a climbing frame, swings, a slide and some monkey bars.

Miss Whiteley asked them if they would like any improvements made to the playground itself such as markings and suggested a giant chess board. Miss Whiteley also asked if they thought children would like some picnic tables with game boards marked on the table tops. The council liked these ideas and thought they would be good additions to their own.

#### **3. Trim Trail and Playground Improvements**

The School Council went outside to look at the space where the current trim trail is located and surrounding areas.

Miss Whiteley asked the council to visualise where the play equipment they would like could be positioned.

The representatives walked around the area and discussed possible locations for some of the equipment that they would like.

- 2) *Representatives to draw a sketch of the play equipment in those locations and present at the next school council meeting.*
