Welcome

Miss Whiteley and Abdul (Chair) welcomed everyone to the meeting including Mr Moore and Mrs Duba.

1. Positive Behaviour Policy

Mr Moore led the discussion on the Positive Behaviour Policy document that Mr Spink had asked the children to review.

The representatives in particular talked about the reward system and they would like in addition to the 'Governors' Award' a special trip.

Mobile phones also sparked a discussion and general confiscation of property. The Year 6 council representatives asked if there was a better place for mobile phones to be stored other than on the front desk as at times when they have gone to collect their phones there had been no one there so were unable to do so.

Overall the council decided that they agreed with the content of the policy.

Action: Class representatives to talk to their classes about the Positive Behaviour Policy and about the rewards and should there be a special trip organised for those eligible children.

2. Trim Trail Rules

Miss Whiteley talked about having some rules for the trim trail so that everyone knew how to use the trim trail correctly.

This sparked lots of discussion and eventually the representatives suggested the following rules:

- ❖ Only use the trim trail when it is dry
- ❖ Do not use before or after school
- ❖ Only use the trim trail if there is an adult supervising
- ❖ Do not eat or drink whilst using the trim trail
- ❖ Wear the correct clothing and shoes when using the trim trail
- ❖ Use the correct one way system

Action: School Council representatives to discuss with their classes the suggested rules and add any other rules or decide if there are ones suggested that are not needed.

3. Quiet Garden Rules

The representatives talked about what rules that we could have for the quiet garden and have suggested the following:

- ❖ Do sit down and talk quietly
- ❖ Respect the garden
- ❖ Respect each other while using the garden

Action: Class representatives to talk to their classes about what rules they would like for the quiet garden.
