### 1. Welcome

#### 2. Roles

#### 3. House Charities

Having narrowed down the charities to four, Miss Whiteley selected a representative from each House to select from 'the hat' which charity each house would be fundraising for this year.

# 4. Children in Need

This year school will be raising money for Children in Need on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November, Miss Whiteley informed the council. Both children and staff will be invited to come to school in sports clothes (donate £1) and take part in the Big Morning Move. Mrs Walker will also be baking cakes with a small number of children to sell after school that day in order to raise more money.
