1. Welcome

In Saffron's (chair) absence Miss Whiteley welcomed the school council representatives to the meeting and in particular to the two new members, Simrath and Isha who will be taking on the roles of EYFS representative and Parent/School Governor Representative respectively.

2. Fundraising Feedback

Further to the previous meetings discussion Miss Whiteley asked the Year 1 and 2 representatives who were present for their class suggestions of charities that the four houses could support this year.

The rest of the council found it disappointing as either still no class discussions had taken place or those that had spoken with their class had not written down the suggestions so could not remember what they were.

Miss Whiteley and Miss Nicholson suggested to the council that they should vote based on the suggestions already received at the previous meeting and not to leave it for another week. The Council agreed and a show of hands were made for each charity that Miss Whiteley read out. The four charities that received the most votes were then put into a 'hat'. Members of the council, one representing each house were asked to pull out of the 'hat' a paper, each had the name of a charity on it and that charity would be supported by that house for the year.

The results were:

Sunningdale: Guide Dogs for the Blind
Wentworth: Candlelighters
Birkdale: Martin House Hospice
Turnberry: Faith Mount School, Kenya

Action: *Jaivon and Isha to produce a piece for the school newsletter with the names of the charity that each house will be supporting this year*

3. AOB

Miss Whiteley mentioned about possibly having a fundraising team with members consisting of all four of the houses. They would be responsible for receiving any fundraising ideas from their house members, liaising with School Council and for organising fundraising events.
